(NIV version except where noted)

**A – Romans 3:23**

For ALL have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

**B – Acts 16:31**

They replied, “BELIEVE in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved – you and your household.”

**C – I Corinthians 15:3**

For what I received I passed on to you as first of importance: that CHRIST died for our sins according to the scriptures.

**D – Psalms 34:14**

Turn from evil and DO good; seek peace and pursue it.

**E – Psalms 100:4**

ENTER his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name.

**M – Judges 5:3**

**S** – Matthew 6:33

**U** – Titus 2:12
